MINUTES OF BUSINESS MEETING
MISSISSIPPI WATER & SEWAGE WORKS OPERATORS ASSOCIATION

The meeting was called to order at 11:25 a.m. by President Malvin Sartin.

The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

The financial report of the Association was presented and approved. The report showed the Association to have a free balance of \$688.34 as of March 17, 1966. This balance did not include dues collected since March 3.

The Secretary reported that the ~~1965~~ ¹⁹⁶⁶ paid membership reached a total of ~~129~~ ¹⁰⁹.

John L. McElroy, Jr., Chairman of the Nominating Committee presented the Committee report:

There being no nominations from the floor, the committee nominees were elected by acclamation.

Lester Ellis of Clarksdale was elected Director for District I. Joseph L. Chapman was elected Director for District IV.

McElroy discussed the need to work for self-improvement.

Joe Brown made a report on pending legislation about water quality and the M.M.A. sponsored proposal for an Air & Water Pollution Control Commission.

McElroy moved that a resolution be drawn up and sent to Governor Paul B. Johnson, endorsing the provisions of the Model Act for State Water Pollution Control Legislation as prepared and amended by the United States Public Health Service. The motion was seconded and adopted, and the Secretary was directed to prepare the resolution in suitable form for mailing to Governor Johnson, with carbon copies to go to Senator Ollie Mohamed and Representative Albert V. Miller, Chairmen of the Committees handling the pending legislation.

McElroy reported on plans for special study session to be held monthly in District IV.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:20 p.m.
