Minutes of Business Meeting  
MISSISSIPPI WATER AND SEWAGE WORKS OPERATORS ASSOCIATION

Meeting called to order at 11:00 AM by President Charles M. Brock.

President Brock proposed that Professor Howard K. Williford be honored by being elected to Honorary Life Membership. The proposal was approved by unanimous vote of members present. Professor Williford expressed his sincere appreciation for this coveted honor. Professor <sup>Williford</sup> is the first and only person thus honored by the association.

The minutes of the previous meeting were approved as read. Professor Williford referred to the Newsletter dated November 18, 1963, in explaining ~~that~~ action of the Board of Governors in regard to the proposed dues change, voted on at the last business meeting.

The financial report was presented and approved. The report showed a free balance of \$409.64 as of March 10, 1964.

The report of the nominating committee was presented. President-Elect F. M. Kirkpatrick was elected President by acclamation. Mr. J. P. Phillips was elected President-Elect by acclamation. Mr. Wilson Ruff was elected Director for District V. Mr. Melvin P. Sartin was elected Director for District II.

The work of District associations was discussed. District IV reported more than a year of monthly district meetings. District V reported three very successful monthly meetings. District II reported an organizational meeting, held on February 27 in Tupelo, with plans for continued monthly meetings. Mr. Ed May of Hinds County Water Company announced a called meeting for Thursday, March 12, in Jackson, for the purpose of organizing District III. Secretary Williford suggested that District Associations adopt an annual dues sufficient to handle mailing costs for the district.
