

May 18, 1965

Minutes of Business Meeting
Mississippi Water and Sewage Works Operators Association

Meeting was called to order at 11:00 a.m., Tuesday, May 18, by President F. M. Kirkpatrick.

The minutes of the previous business meeting were read and approved.

The financial report of the Association was presented and approved. The report showed the Association to have a free balance of \$491.94 as of May 13, 1965. Secretary Williford stated that this balance obviously did not reflect the dues collected on May 17 and 18, 1965.

Secretary Williford reported that the 1964 paid membership reached a total of 159.

The report of the nominating committee was presented. President-Elect J. P. Phillips having requested in writing that he not be considered for the Presidency, Mr. Malvin Sartin of Columbus was nominated, and was elected by acclamation. Mr. Ed May of Jackson was nominated for office of President-Elect and was elected by acclamation. Howard K. Williford was re-elected Secretary-Treasurer.

A Director for District III was scheduled for election. Representatives from District III requested and were granted the privilege of electing the new Director at their next District meeting. The election of Malvin Sartin to the Presidency created a Director vacancy in District II, as Mr. Sartin's term as director did not expire until 1966. Representatives of District II requested and were granted the privilege of electing a Director to complete Mr. Sartin's unexpired term at the next District meeting.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 11:45 a.m.
