Dear Governor Johnson:

WHEREAS: It has been brought to our attention that recent Federal legislation makes it imperative for the State of Mississippi to establish and enforce water quality criteria and standards for the waters of our state and that new State Legislation appears necessary to establish or designate an agency for this purpose, and

WHEREAS: We feel that proposed legislation now under advisement may not be suitable to serve to the best interests of the people of Mississippi,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That we, the members of the Mississippi Water and Sewage Works Operators' Association, assembled in our twelfth annual meeting at Mississippi State University, State College, Mississippi, on March 22, 1966, do hereby recommend that the Mississippi Legislature consider the adoption of the Model Act for State Water Pollution Control Legislation as prepared and amended by the United States Public Health Service and as endorsed by the Mississippi Water Pollution Control Association at its annual meeting, in Jackson, Mississippi, on March 11, 1966.
